E.3: use of the building	The building was a 'living house' occupied by an extended family in the traditional manner. More recently, it served as a bungalow – what does this mean? A single family? After the Tsunami it was re-used as a house since the owner lost his other house that was located in the Tsunami affected area.
E.4: changes to the building	This building was formerly built in the hinterland of Indrapuri jungle then it was moved to the Lubuk village. Only the main structures were moved to the new site. The columns and beams were transported through the Krueng Aceh river. The house was re-built in the new site combined with the new material but the Aceh traditional style of this building was retained. Can you also show where Indrapuri is on the map? Was the side house added?
